



NOVA is committed to the continuing legal education of its members. NOVA's Board of Directors has approved a recommendation from the seminar committee to provide further education to the membership by offering continuing legal education by way of the internet. Beginning in January of 2012, NOVA will expand its legal education opportunities by offering online webinars to supplement NOVA's biannual seminars.

The webinars will provide an in depth analysis of veterans law and procedure. The online presentations are intended to explore new ideas and concepts. The focus of each presentation will be on more complex topics and strategies for representing your clients. The goal of the webinars will be to provide practitioners with new ways of thinking and approaching the representation of veterans and their families.

The first webinar will be on January 27, 2011 and will feature a two hour presentation by NOVA member Ken Carpenter. The focus of the presentation will be on claims for total rating based on unemployability. Specifically, an examination of the provisions of 38 C.F.R. 4.16 and how to argue those provisions before the VA, the Board and the Court will be explored.

Registration for the webinar will be available through the NOVA homepage. You must register and pay online by December 30, 2011 to receive the early bird registration of \$200.00. After that date, the program cost will be \$250.00. Program materials will be available for you to download during the presentation. A Certificate of Attendance will be e-mailed to each paid registrant in order for you to pursue CLE credit in your state.
